

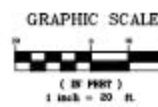
- REQUIREMENTS FOR WOOD BARRIER**
1. MINIMUM RADIUS TO BE PROTECTED IS ENTIRE SHOULDER
 2. MINIMA 3' IN HEIGHT
 3. UPPOINIS - THE EQUIVLENT OF 2"x4" LUMBER OR 8" MINIMUM CENTERS
 4. HORIZONTALS - THE EQUIVLENT OF TWO COURSES OF 1/2" ROPIING WITH YELLOW PLASTIC TAPE FLOPING
 5. BARRIERS TO BE ERCTED AROUND TREES TO REMAIN BEFORE CONSTRUCTION OR WHEN TREES TO REMAIN ARE REQUIRED
 6. BARRIERS TO REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL ALL PAVING, CONSTRUCTION AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT IS OUT OF AREA

- 3) ALL LANDSCAPED AND BENDED AREAS DELINEATED ON THESE PLANS SHALL BE IRRIGATED BY AN AUTOMATIC SYSTEM. THE IRRIGATION SYSTEM SHALL PROVIDE SUFFICIENT TO-IRIGATE COVERAGE TO ALL AREAS OF PLANTING.
- 4) ALL LANDSCAPED BEDS SHALL BE TOP DRESSED WITH 3" OF FINE DARK HUSSET PULCH.
- 5) ALL TREE BEDDERS SHALL BE TOP DRESSED WITH 3" OF FINE DARK HUSSET PULCH.
- 6) IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR TO REDUCE PLANT KILLING WITH EXCESS WATER. CONDUCT REGULAR INSPECTIONS OF PLANTS AND ARCHITECTURAL PLANTS AS TO PREVENT DAMAGE DURING THE INSTALLATION OF THE LANDSCAPE SYSTEMS.
- 7) STAKING OF TREES IS AT THE OPTION OF THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR. HOWEVER, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR TO MAINTAIN ALL TREES, PLANTS AND SHRUBS IN AN UPRIGHT PLANT CONDITION.
- 8) THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING CURBS OR PAVED SURFACES.
- 9) ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE GRADED FLORIDA 1 ACCORDING TO THE GRADES AND STANDARDS OF THE FLORIDA NURSERYMAN'S ASSOCIATION.
- 10) ALL TREE CALIPER DIMENSIONS SHALL BE MEASURED 1" ABOVE THE TOP OF THE ROOT BALL.
- 11) THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ALL SHRUBS FOR A PERIOD OF NINETEEN (19) DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE FINAL ACCEPTANCE BY THE CLIENT AND LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. ALL TREES SHALL CARRY A MINIMUM ONE YEAR WARRANTY. ALL WARRANTY REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE SPECIFIED IN WRITING AND SHALL BE PART OF THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS PROVIDED TO THE CLIENT BY THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR.
- 12) CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PLANT AND SOIL QUANTITY TAKE-OFF. QUANTITIES PROVIDED FOR CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE USED FOR ORDERING PLANT MATERIAL.
