AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ANNEXING TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN LAND GENERALLY LOCATED SOUTH OF HOFFNER AVENUE, EAST OF CONWAY ROAD AND WEST OF KEMPSTON DRIVE AND COMPRISED OF 0.713 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS; AMENDING THE CITY'S ADOPTED GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY AS OFFICE LOW INTENSITY ON THE CITY'S OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND USE MAPS; DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY AS THE O-1 LOW INTENSITY OFFICE-RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT ALONG WITH THE AIRCRAFT NOISE AND CONWAY ROAD SPECIAL PLAN OVERLAY DISTRICTS, ON THE CITY'S OFFICIAL ZONING MAPS: PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND USE AND ZONING MAPS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, PERMIT DISCLAIMER, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2017, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "Orlando City Council"), accepted a petition for voluntary annexation (hereinafter the "petition") bearing the signatures of all owners of property in an area of land generally located south of Hoffner Avenue, east of Conway Road, and west of Kempston Drive, such land comprised of approximately 0.713 acres of land and being precisely described by the legal description of the area by metes and bounds attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A (hereinafter "the property"); and

WHEREAS, the petition was filed with the Orlando City Council pursuant to section 171.044, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, at its regularly scheduled meeting of July 18, 2017, the Municipal Planning Board (the "MPB") of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "city"), considered the following applications relating to the property:

- 1. Annexation case number ANX2017-00001, requesting to annex the property into the jurisdictional boundaries of the city; and
- 2. Growth Management Plan (hereinafter the "GMP") case number GMP2017-00001, requesting an amendment to the city's GMP to designate the property as "Office Low Intensity" on the City's official future land use map; and
- 3. Zoning case number ZON2017-00002, requesting to designate the property as the O-1 "Low Intensity Office-Residential" district, along with the "Aircraft Noise" and "Conway Road Special Plan" overlay districts, on the City's official zoning maps (together, hereinafter referred to as the "applications"); and

WHEREAS, based upon the evidence presented to the MPB, including the information and analysis contained in the "Staff Report to the Municipal Planning Board" for application case numbers ANX2017-00001, GMP2017-00001, and ZON2017-00002, (entitled "Item #1A., B. &

C-4900 Hoffner Avenue"), the MPB recommended that the Orlando City Council approve said applications and adopt an ordinance in accordance therewith; and

WHEREAS, the MPB found that application GMP2017-00001 is consistent with:

- 1. The *State Comprehensive Plan* as provided at Chapter 187, Florida Statutes (the "State Comprehensive Plan"); and
- 2. The *East Central Florida 2060 Plan* adopted by the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council pursuant to sections 186.507 and 186.508, Florida Statutes (the "Strategic Regional Policy Plan"); and
- 3. The *City of Orlando Growth Management Plan*, adopted as the city's "comprehensive plan" for purposes of the Florida Community Planning Act, sections 163.3164 through 163.3217, Florida Statutes (the "GMP"); and

WHEREAS, the MPB found that application ZON2017-00002 is consistent with:

- 1. The GMP; and
- 2. Chapters 58 through 68, Code of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "LDC"); and

WHEREAS, sections 3 and 4 of this ordinance are adopted pursuant to the process for adoption of a small-scale comprehensive plan amendment as provided by section 163.3187, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Orlando City Council hereby finds that:

- 1. As of the date of the petition, the property was located in the unincorporated area of Orange County; and
- 2. As of the date of the petition, the property is contiguous to the city within the meaning of subsection 171.031(11), Florida Statutes; and
- 3. As of the date of the petition, the property is reasonably compact within the meaning of subsection 171.031(12), Florida Statutes; and
- 4. The petition bears the signatures of all owners of property in the area to be annexed; and
- 5. Annexation of the property will not result in the creation of enclaves within the meaning of subsection 171.031(13), Florida Statutes; and
 - 6. The property is located wholly within the boundaries of a single county; and
- 7. The petition proposes an annexation that is consistent with the purpose of ensuring sound urban development and accommodation to growth; and

100	8. The petition, this ordinance, and the procedures leading to the adoption of this		
101	ordinance are consistent with the uniform legislative standards provided by the Florida Municipa		
102	Annexation and Contraction Act for the adjustment of municipal boundaries; and

104	9. The petition proposes an annexation that is consistent with the purpose of ensuring		
105	the efficient provision of urban services to areas that become urban in character within the		
106	meaning of subsection 171.022(8), Florida Statutes; and		
107			
108	10. The petition proposes an annexation that is consistent with the purpose of ensuring		
109	that areas are not annexed unless municipal services can be provided to those areas; and		
110			
111	WHEREAS, the Orlando City Council hereby finds that this ordinance is in the best		
112	interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, and is consistent with the applicable provisions		
113	of Florida Statutes, the State Comprehensive Plan, the Strategic Regional Policy Plan, and the		
114	city's GMP and LDC; and

116	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE		
117	CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

119	SECTION 1. ANNEXATION. Pursuant to the authority granted by section 171.044,		
120	Florida Statutes, and having determined that the owner or owners of the property have petitioned		
121	the Orlando City Council for annexation into the corporate limits of the city, and having		
122	determined that the petition bears the signatures of all owners of property in the area proposed to		
123	be annexed, and having made the findings set forth in this ordinance, the property is hereby		
124	annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Orlando, Florida, and the boundary lines of the		
125	city are hereby redefined to include the property. In accordance with subsection 171.044(3),		
126	Florida Statutes, the annexed area is clearly shown on the map attached to this ordinance as		
127	Exhibit B.		
128			
129	SECTION 2. CITY BOUNDARIES . Pursuant to section 171.091, Florida Statutes, the		
130	charter boundary article of the city is hereby revised in accordance with this ordinance. The city		
131	clerk, or designee, is hereby directed to file this ordinance as a revision of the City Charter with		
132	the Florida Department of State. The city planning official, or designee, is hereby directed to		
133	amend the city's official maps in accordance with this ordinance.		
134			
135	SECTION 3. FLUM DESIGNATION. Pursuant to section 163.3187, Florida Statutes,		
136	the City of Orlando, Florida, adopted Growth Management Plan Future Land Use Map		
137	designation for the property is hereby established as "Office Low Intensity" as depicted in		
138	Exhibit C to this ordinance.		
139			
140	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT OF FLUM. The City planning official, or designee, is		
141	hereby directed to amend the city's adopted future land use maps in accordance with this		
142	ordinance.		
143			
144	SECTION 5. ZONING DESIGNATION. Pursuant to the City's Land Development		
145	Code, the zoning designation for the property is hereby established as the "Low Intensity Office-		
146	Residential District" along with the "Aircraft Noise" and "Conway Road Special Plan" overlay		
147	districts (denoted on the City's official zoning maps as the "O-1/AN/SP" district), as depicted in		
148	Exhibit D to this ordinance.

150	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT OF OFFICIAL ZONING MAP. The City zoning		
151	official, or designee, is hereby directed to amend the city's official zoning maps in accordance		
152	with this ordinance.

154	SECTION 7. DISCLAIMER. In accordance with Section 166.033(5), Florida Statutes,		
155	the issuance of this development permit does not in any way create any right on the part of the		
156	applicant to obtain a permit from a state or federal agency, and does not create any liability on the		
157	part of the City for issuance of this permit if the applicant fails to obtain requisite approvals or		
158	fulfill the obligations imposed by a state or federal agency or undertakes actions that result in a		
159	violation of state or federal law. All other applicable state or federal permits must be obtained		
160	before commencement of the development authorized by this development permit.

162	SECTION 8. SCRIVENER'S ERROR. The city attorney may correct scrivener's		
163	errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city clerk.		
164	errors round in this ordinance by fining a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city clork.		
165	SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to		
166	any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or		
167	applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or		
168	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.		
169			
170	SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance is effective upon adoption, except		
171	for sections one and two, which take effect on the 30 th day after adoption, and sections three, four,		
172	five, and six, which take effect on the 31st day after adoption unless this ordinance is lawfully		
173	challenged pursuant to section 163.3187(5), Florida Statutes, in which case sections three, four,		
174	five, and six shall not be effective until the state land planning agency or the Administration		
175	Commission issues a final order declaring this ordinance "in compliance" as defined at sections		
176	163.3184(1)(b) and 163.3187(5)(d), Florida Statutes.
