1. DESCRIPTION: The City of Orlando Families, Parks, and Recreation Department (FPR) is requesting approval to accept the Governor's Commission on Community Service Operation AmeriCorps grant. This grant will provide 30 AmeriCorps memberss to the City of Orlando's Families, Parks and Recreation Department as well as a Full Time (Contract) Program Program Manager and a Full Time (Contract) Academic Coordinator. The goal is to ensure that Orlando high school students graduate successfully and have designated future tracks (employment, post-secondary education, technical training, military service or national service). Total program costs are budgeted at \$636,015 per year.
