A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ACCOMMODATE A NEIGHBORHOOD SIGN IN THE LAKE LAWSONA FERN CREEK NEIGHBORHOOD; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation purposes to enter into a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement for the construction of a standalone local identification marker sign for the Lake Lawsona Fern Creek Neighborhood in Orange County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to agree by Resolution to approve the project and to fund all costs for the design, installation, and maintenance of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City has approved the Community Aesthetics Feature Agreement on July 10, 2017 and hereby agrees by Resolution to fund all costs for the design, installation, and maintenance of the project; and

WHEREAS, the identification marker sign for the Lake Lawsona Fern Creek Neighborhood will be located in FDOT's right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION 1. – The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor/Mayor Pro Tem of the City of Orlando to execute and deliver this Resolution approving the Project and authority to enter into and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement.

SECTION 2. – This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
