### 1st ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES RFP18-0197

### HEALTH CARE AND BENEFITS CONSULTANT APRIL 6, 2018 AT 9:30 A.M. CITY HALL – $4^{TH}$ FLOOR, DOLPHIN CONFERENCE ROOM

The 1<sup>st</sup> Advisory Committee (Committee) for the above solicitation convened on April 6, 2018, in the

Dolphin Conference Room, City Hall. The purpose of this meeting was to review the responsive proposals in response to RFP18-0197 including the Proposal Worksheet side-by-side comparisons including references, and to review, score, and rank each of those firm's proposals.

### **Actions/Discussion/Motions:**

Brian Ferrier, Facilitator, introduced himself and took the following actions:

- 1. Called the meeting to order at 9:41 a.m.
- 2. Reminded everyone that the meeting is being recorded.
- 3. Had all Committee members and others present introduce themselves.
- 4. Advised that the Committee was approved and ethics forms were received.
- 5. Advised the Committee that a quorum was established.
- 6. Announced that the meeting was publicly posted for more than 48 hours in advance.
- 7. Asked all attendees to sign the sign-in sheet.
- 8. Facilitator reviewed Advisory Committee Rules.
- 9. Reviewed Public Input Procedures Explained that, though **no** public representatives were present, policy requires that public input be allowed prior to each vote on non-ministerial motions.

A motion was made by <u>Ana Palenzuela</u>, and seconded by <u>Rodney Williams</u>, to accept the Public Input Procedures. The motion carried unanimously.

Brian Ferrier indicated that a copy of the solicitation, addenda, proposals, and proposal worksheets including references were distributed to the Committee.

### **DISCUSSION AND MOTIONS:**

Jessica Mason described the role of the Health Care and Benefits Consultant to the Committee.

Dawn Chin Shue briefly discussed the MBE/WBE portion of the proposals. She indicated that there was no opportunity for MBE/WBE participation in this solicitation.

Brian Ferrier briefly discussed the VBE portion of the proposals. He indicated that there was no opportunity for VBE participation in this solicitation.

Brian Ferrier gave the Committee an overview of the options to short-list proposers, potential presentations, time allotted for each presenter and any specific agenda expected from the presenters. General discussion ensued.

The Committee indicated they would first like Jessica Mason to review the Proposer's worksheet sideby-side comparisons with the committee. Jessica Mason proceeded with the review of the Proposer's worksheet side-by-side comparison. General discussion ensued.

A motion was made by <u>Deborah Girard</u>, and seconded by <u>Ana Palenzuela</u>, not to Short List the Proposers. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by <u>Ana Palenzuela</u>, and seconded by <u>Rodney Williams</u>, to not schedule Proposer presentations. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by <u>Ana Palenzuela</u>, and seconded by <u>Rodney Williams</u>, to not to run D& B Financial Reports because Committee determined that D & B Reports were not necessary for this solicitation. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by <u>Rodney Williams</u>, and seconded by <u>Ana Palenzuela</u>, to Score and Rank the Proposals. The motion carried unanimously.

Brian Ferrier distributed the Proposal Evaluation forms to the Committee members. He explained the Scoring and Ranking process to the Committee. The Committee members scored and ranked the Proposals independently. Scoring and Ranking forms were tallied by Brian Ferrier.

The resulting Final Ranking is as follows:

- 1) RobinsonBush, Inc.
- 2) First Florida Insurance Brokers (FFIB)
- 3) BT&T Insurance Services, Inc.

A motion was made by <u>Tony Blanca</u> and seconded by <u>Ana Palenzuela</u> to accept the ranking and evaluations of the proposals, and recommend to City Council that the Chief Procurement Officer negotiate and execute a contract with the top ranked proposer RobinsonBush, Inc.

Antonio Blanca, Advisory Committee Chair, adjourned the meeting at 12:02 p.m.

These minutes are considered to be the official minutes of the RFP18-0197 Advisory Committee Meeting held on April 6, 2018, and no other notes, tapes, or other recordings taken by anyone takes precedence.

Note: One of the Committee members Proposal Evaluation form had a math error on the total score. However, correction of the error does not change the end result of the Committee's ranking and recommendation.




