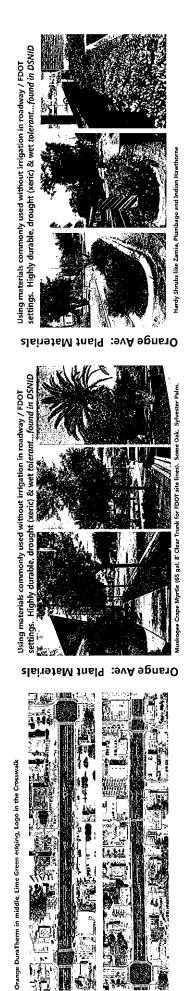


Orange Ave: Lighting Option

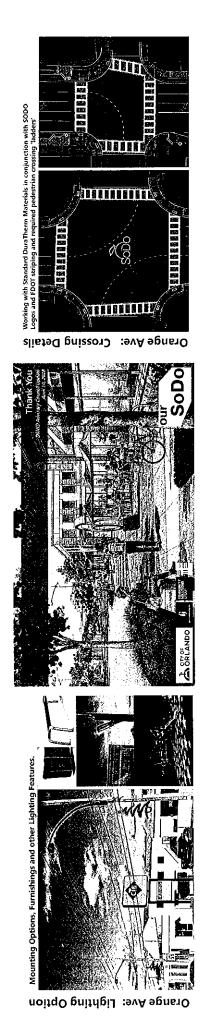
