1. **DESCRIPTION:** The Orlando Citywide Pedestrian Signal project consists of the design of pedesrian infrastructure improvements at 37 signalized intersections within the Central Business District and the Downtown South Main Street District of Orlando. The project limits include S Orange Ave from Michigan St to Central Blvd, S Magnolia Ave and S Rosalind Ave from E Anderson St to E Central Blvd, Hughey Ave and Garland Ave from W South St to W Amelia St, and Boone Ave from W Anderson St to W South St. Proposed improvements included reconstruction of sidewalk curb ramps and pedestrian push buttons to being into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), modifications to pedestrian signal heads as necessary, updates to pedestrian signal timing, and installation of accessible pedestrain signal features to aid the visually impaired.
