AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, RELATING TO REGIONAL PUBLIC FACILITY DESIGNATION AND SIGNAGE; APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE MASTER SIGN PLAN FOR THE DR. PHILLIPS CENTER PURSUANT TO SECTION 64.320, ORLANDO CITY CODE; PROVIDING **FOR** CONFLICTS, PENALTIES, SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, PERMIT DISCLAIMER, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, section 64.320, Code of the City of Orlando, Florida (the "Orlando City Code") provides that the Orlando City Council may approve signage for regional landmarks and regional facilities which serve the greater metropolitan area and/or the tourist population; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2014, the Orlando City Council approved by ordinance (Ordinance No. 2014-67, Document #1412151202) a master sign plan as part of a Planned Development Ordinance Amendment, that recognized (1) the Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts (the "Dr. Phillips Center") as a regional public landmark within the meaning of section 64.320, Orlando City Code, (2) the signage described and depicted therein fosters the public health, safety, and welfare by promoting safe and efficient public access to the regional facility, and (3) such signage does not have a negative impact on surrounding land uses (the "Master Sign Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Dr. Phillips Center is requesting an amendment to the Master Sign Plan to include a replacement sign for a new donor sign and reconfigure the building identification sign that is to be mounted on the center's southern façade for the School of the Arts; and

WHEREAS, the planning official determination dated October 15, 2018, attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A, supports the amendment to the Master Sign Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Orlando City Council hereby finds and declares that this ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, and that it advances a valid and important public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. MASTER SIGN PLAN AMENDED. In accordance with section 64.320, Orlando City Code, the Orlando City Council hereby approves the amendment described and depicted in Exhibit B to this ordinance (the "School of the Arts Sign"), which exhibit replaces and supersedes that portion of Exhibit D, Sheet S-15 of the Master Sign Plan that relates to the School of the Arts graphics. The Master Sign Plan is still in full force and effect, and governs the sign plan for the Dr. Phillips Center, except

as expressly provided herein. The School of the Arts sign will not require a variance and will not need future planning official determination(s) as long as the proposed sign sizes and locations match those set forth in Exhibit B to this ordinance.
SECTION 2. CONFLICTS. In the event of conflict, the text of this ordinance controls over the depictions, descriptions, and text contained within the exhibits to this ordinance.
SECTION 3. PENALTY. Violations of this ordinance are violations of the City's land development code and shall be punished as provided therein.
SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
SECTION 5. SCRIVENER'S ERROR. The city attorney may correct scrivener's errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city clerk.
SECTION 6. DISCLAIMER. In accordance with section 166.033(5), Florida Statutes, the issuance of this development permit does not in any way create any right on the part of the applicant to obtain a permit from a state or federal agency, and does not create any liability on the part of the city for issuance of this permit if the applicant fails to obtain requisite approvals or fulfill the obligations imposed by a state or federal agency or undertakes actions that result in a violation of state or federal law. All other applicable state or federal permits must be obtained before commencement of the development authorized by this development permit.
SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance takes effect upon adoption.
