

1 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
 2 **ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 39, ORLANDO**
 3 **CITY CODE, ORLANDO TRAFFIC AND PARKING CODE, BY**
 4 **AMENDING SECTION 39.68 TO INCREASE VARIOUS FINE**
 5 **AMOUNTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF**
 6 **CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND ACTIONS,**
 7 **CODIFICATION, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER’S ERRORS,**
 8 **AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 **WHEREAS**, The Orlando City Council hereby finds and declares that amending
 11 the City’s current Code regulations relating to certain parking fine amounts, as provided
 12 in this ordinance, will appropriately address the severity of the violation and ensure that
 13 the City’s parking fines are more consistent; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Orlando City Council hereby finds and determines that
 16 amending the City’s current regulations as provided in this ordinance is in the best
 17 interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, and is in harmony with the purpose and
 18 intent of the City’s Traffic and Parking Code.
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20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY**
 21 **OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**
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23 **SECTION 1. CHAPTER 39 AMENDED.** Section 39.68, Code of the City of
 24 Orlando, Florida, is hereby amended as follows:
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26 *Sec. 39.68. – Schedule of Loading and Unloading Zone Tag Permit Fees,*
 27 *Civil Penalties for Parking Violations, and Fee for Removal of an Immobilization*
 28 *Device.*

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32 (2) There is hereby adopted the following schedule of civil penalties for parking
 33 violations occurring within the City of Orlando for which payment may be made at the
 34 Parking Bureau:
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	Violation	Civil Penalty
(a)	Parking overtime (limit authorized in zone)	\$20 <u>15</u> .00
(b)	Meter violation overtime	\$20 <u>15</u> .00
(c)	Failure or refusal to pay parking facility parking fee	\$20 <u>15</u> .00

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(d)	Parking over line	\$20 <u>15</u> .00
(e)	Parking vehicle without affixed current registration license plate and validation sticker	\$20 <u>15</u> .00
(f)	No parking—yellow or red curb	\$30.00
(g)	No parking—on sidewalk	\$30.00
(h)	No parking—on crosswalk	\$30.00
(i)	No parking—blocking driveway	\$30.00
(j)	No parking—blocking dumpster	\$30.00
(k)	No parking—blocking wheelchair ramp	\$40.00
(l)	No parking—within 30 ft. of official traffic control device	\$30.00
(m)	No parking—within 30 feet nearest rail at railroad crossing	\$30.00
(n)	No parking—loading and unloading by permit only	\$30.00
(o)	No parking—City Hall not on City business	\$30.00
(p)	No parking—City employee parking in City Hall public use space	\$30.00
(q)	No Parking—safety zone	\$30.00
(r)	Parking prohibited by sign	\$30.00
(s)	Parking in parking space reserved for assigned personnel only	\$30.00
(t)	Improper parking—obstructing traffic	\$30.00
(u)	Improper parking—left wheels to curb (on 2-way street)	\$30.00
(v)	Improper parking—wrong way on one-way street (parked facing opposite flow of traffic)	\$30.00

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(w)	Improper parking—parked with front of vehicle facing driving lane	\$30.00
(x)	Parking commercial or recreational vehicle in residential or office zoning district	\$30.00
(y)	Parking not within an approved vehicular use area	\$30.00
(z)	Parking in fire lane	\$30.00
(aa)	Blocking fire hydrant	\$30.00
(bb)	Permit parking only	\$30.00
(cc)	Parking vehicle upon any particular street for longer than seventy-two (72) consecutive hours	\$30.00
(dd)	Parking by disabled permit only	\$250.00
(ee)	Parking violation where civil penalty amount not specified	\$15.00
(ff)	Parking in access aisles designated for use by persons who have disabled parking permits	\$250.00

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SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances previously adopted and in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. CODIFICATION. The city clerk and the city attorney shall cause the Code of the City of Orlando, Florida, to be amended as provided by this ordinance and may renumber, re-letter, and rearrange the codified parts of this ordinance if necessary to facilitate the finding of the law.

SECTION 5. SCRIVENER'S ERROR. The city attorney may correct scrivener's errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city clerk.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance takes effect upon adoption.
