AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, RELATING TO A STREET NAME CHANGE; RENAMING THE WESTERLY PORTION OF “MAJOR BOULEVARD,” AS DESCRIBED IN THE PLAT UNIVERSAL CITY FLORIDA, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 35, PAGE 84, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, GENERALLY LOCATED WEST OF KIRKMAN ROAD AND EAST OF UNIVERSAL BOULEVARD TO “TOM WILLIAMS WAY”; DIRECTING AMENDMENTS TO THE OFFICIAL MAPS OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER’S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there exists a certain segment of public right-of-way within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Orlando, Florida, currently known and marked, and designated on the official maps of the City of Orlando, Florida, as “Major Boulevard,” and

WHEREAS, Mr. Tom Williams, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Universal Parks and Resorts, led the design and development of Universal Orlando Resort into a world-class Orlando destination comprised of Universal Studios, Universal’s Islands of Adventure, Universal’s Volcano Bay, Universal CityWalk and several on-site hotels; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of this, and in honor of his retirement, the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida (the “Orlando City Council”), hereby finds that it is fitting to rename a portion of the public street currently known as Major Boulevard, and running within Universal Orlando Resort, to bear the name of Mr. Williams; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. STREET NAME CHANGE. After due notice and public hearing, and having met all other conditions precedent in accordance with sections 65.537 and 65.538, Code of

the City of Orlando, Florida, and all other applicable law, the name of the public street segment described and depicted in Exhibit “A” to this ordinance is hereby changed from “Major Boulevard” to “Tom Williams Way.”

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF OFFICIAL MAPS. The city clerk, the City planning official, the city engineer, and the City zoning official, or their respective designees, are hereby directed to amend the City’s official maps in accordance with this ordinance.

SECTION 3. SCRIVENER’S ERROR. The city attorney may correct scrivener’s errors found in this ordinance by filing a corrected copy of this ordinance with the city clerk.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance takes effect immediately upon final passage.
