The Toughbiker Corporation is a registered 501(c) 3 tax exempt organization under the Internal Revenue Service codes, number 47-5238053. The organization was founded and is comprised of law enforcement officers in the Central Florida area. Our mission is to make a difference with the homeless, low-income youth in the community who experience negative effects of at-risk behavior. Toughbiker is dedicated to creating an environment where they could learn both a skill and a creative form of recreation while at the same time break down existing negative barriers between law enforcement and the community.

We provide the bicycles, helmets, hydration and nutrition before, during and after the rides. We provide safety equipment for all the kids. We conduct basic mountain bike skills training to teach them how to properly ride and navigate obstacles. We ride weekly to keep up their skills and provide mentoring during this time. Our weekly rides are held at the Orlando Mountain Bike Park, but we also travel to more challenging trails throughout the state. We hold 3-4 bike ride events throughout the year at various locations throughout the city to raise community awareness for our program.

Toughbiker is an extremely positive organization providing the Orlando Police Department the opportunity to educate citizens, demonstrate leadership and community involvement. Most importantly, your contribution will make a difference in a child's life.

The program provides the youth with challenging obstacles, teaching them to overcome them through positive training. This method builds their self-confidence to positively overcome obstacles in their life, increasing their ability to deal with stressful situations in a more positive manner. Riding 2-3 days a week keeps them occupied and wanting to stay in top physical condition for riding and races keeps them for drug use and activities which will have adverse effects on their lives. How will the project/program be evaluated for success? The program is long term as I mainly work with 6-12th grade youth. The youth are evaluated each training ride to determine if their skill level has increased, how they deal with others in positive/negative manner, conduct towards the public and land management skills. Describe anticipated recurring costs for subsequent fiscal years. The only anticipated yearly recurring costs are for website/internet/email service, insurance, mailbox, race league dues/fees, bike equipment and maintenance and events.
