### Mayor's Update

#### **Council Chambers**

Mayor Dyer welcomed everyone to the first Council meeting back in the renovated Council Chambers. He thanked City staff who worked hard, especially over the last several weeks, to make sure that Council would be accommodated in the Chambers today. Technology will continue to be upgraded, but energy efficiency improvements were made, including improvements to the acoustics and lighting, as well as outlets at every member of the public's chairs. Electrical connections will be available after the first floor renovation is complete.

### Passing of Randall James

Mayor Dyer acknowledged the passing of Randall James, who was very important to the City family for over three or four decades. Randall was the Chief of Staff to three different Mayors and Chief of Staff informally to more Mayors than that. Mayor Dyer asked for a moment of silence to remember Randall.

#### **Venues**

Mayor Dyer noted that Venues were busy this week. Between the Beyonce and Jay-Z concert and the Alabama/Louisville game, the City had over a hundred thousand people attend the two events at Camping World Stadium. Mayor Dyer thanked staff and Florida Citrus Sports for making the transition between the concert and the football game in such a short time.

### Hispanic Heritage Month Kick Off

Mayor Dyer invited the public to join himself and Commissioner Tony Ortiz as the City kicks off Hispanic Heritage Month on Wednesday, September 12. Hispanic Heritage Month runs from the September 15 through October 15, 2018, and recognizes the culture and traditions of U.S. residents who trace their roots to Spain, Mexico and the Spanish-speaking nations in Central America, South America, and the Caribbean. The Hispanic Heritage Month Kick Off event will take place at Leu Gardens, 1920 N Forest Avenue.
