Request for a major certificate of appearance approval of a 5-story multifamily building with 106 units and 135 space parking garage.

The subject property is addressed as 630 W. Amelia Street and generally located north of West Livingston Street, east of north Paramore Avenue, south of west Amelia Street and west of north Terry Avenue (PID: 29-22-26-1853-02-000) (±1.6 acres, District 5).

Using a PowerPoint, Richard Forbes provided an overview of the project.

Requested clarification on a few conditions of approval in the staff report such as the street maintenance agreement and the City services agreement, the façade windows and shadow lines, the mechanical equipment, the venting, the exhaust requirements and conditions and the telecommunication screening.

Discussion ensued between staff, applicant and other speakers regarding the exhaust venting and its location, tenant space, transparency, elevations, building façade, entrances, awnings, additional trees within the streetscape areas, curb cuts and traffic circulation, entrance tile color and material, final site plan review and future development of the Federal Street Plans and Streetscape.

Applicant agreed to the conditions of approval listed in the staff report.

ELISABETH DANG MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE ARB2022-10052, THE BEACON MAJOR-FINAL REVIEW WITH ALL CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL LIST IN THE STAFF REPORT WITH THE ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STAFF TO WORK WITH APPLICANT TO RESOLVE THE ISSUES REGARDING THE ENTRY FEATURE AT PARRAMORE AND AMELIA, AS WELL AS THE DOOR ENTRIES; ALSO RECOMMENDING TO REVIEW ADDING ADDITIONAL ARTICULATION ALONG THE FAÇADES TO BREAK UP SOME OF THE FLAT AREAS, AND TO REVIEW THE CURB CUTS ALONG PUTNAM AND TO ADD ADDITIONAL STREET TREES ON PUTNUM, AND TO ELIMINATE CONDITION 3F IN THE STAFF REPORT AS THAT IS BEING ADDRESSED DIFFERENTLY.
