Recipient, the City of Orlando and the Florida Department of Transportation, desires to supplement the original Agreement entered into and executed on January 13, 2022 as identified above. All provisions in the original Agreement and supplements, if any, remain in effect except as expressly modified by this supplement.

The changes to the Agreement and supplements, if any, are described as follows:

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**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Name Edgewater Drive Complete Streets Length \_\_\_\_\_

Termini Lakeview Street to Par Street

Description of Work:

This project consists of the final design for a complete streets enhancement to Edgewater Drive from just south of Lakeview Street to just north of West Par Street, and also includes improvements along portions of West Par Street and Princeton Street. The proposed design for Edgewater Drive will evaluate 10 foot wide travel lanes, on street parking, bicycle lanes, sharrows, sidewalks and enhancements to the pedestrian and bicycle facilities along the corridor. ADA compliant infrastructure, lighting, signing and pavement markings, drainage improvements, basic landscaping, and intersection improvements will also be included.

The City of Orlando (Recipient) will need to review potential contamination sites along the project to ensure there is no interaction. In addition, the City (Recipient) may need to develop Section 4(f) documentation for publicly owned properties. Moreover, the project is located within an eligible historic district which will need to be accounted for as part of the cultural resource analysis; this analysis will cover the entire limits of the project. The City (Recipient) will also need to provide a protected species evaluation. Coordination with utility companies located along the corridor will also be required. Permitting is anticipated. Additional Right-of-Way is not anticipated; however, coordination with adjacent properties will be required for the proposed roundabout at Edgewater Drive and Lakeview Street.

Reason for Supplement and supporting engineering and/or cost analysis:

1. Pursuant to Paragraph 4.0 Project Cost of the Local Agency Program Agreement, the Recipient and the Department acknowledge and agree that the Schedule of Financial Assistance for Design that includes the authorized and encumbered Federal funding on the project shall be increased to an amount equal to the Recipient's consultant contract award amount of **\$1,023,212.00**. This results in an increase of total design funding by \$23,212.00. The federal funding is to be increased by \$23,212.00, which is the difference between previous federal funding of \$1,000,000.00 and the current federal funding of \$1,023,212.00.

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2. Revisions to the federal funding amounts attributed to the amounts referenced above are reflected in the Adjusted Exhibit "B" Schedule of Financial Assistance, and in Exhibit "E", Federal Financial Assistance (Single Audit Act), attached hereto and incorporated herein.
3. The Recipient Resolution authorizing entry into this Supplemental Agreement is attached and incorporated into this Supplemental Agreement as Exhibit "D".
