We are very glad you have joined us for today's hearing. Proceedings before a Local Hearing Officer are a quasi-judicial forum. The Hearing Officer will preside over the suspension and/or revocation of an establishment's After Midnight Alcohol Sales Permit pursuant to Chapter 33, Code of the City of Orlando.

General Rules of Order

The Hearing Officer is pleased to hear all non-repetitive comments relating to your challenge of the permit violation. The Local Hearing Officer governs the conduct of the hearing. If you wish to appear before the Hearing Officer, you must fill out a Request to Speak Form and give it to the Administrative Assistant. When you are recognized you, state your name, address, and relationship to the property, and speak directly into the microphone.

Appeals

If you wish to appeal the ruling of the Hearing Officer, you may request a hearing before the Code Enforcement Board within 14 days after issuance of an order of suspension or revocation. The request for a hearing in front of the Code Enforcement Board must be in writing and shall not stay the effect of a Suspension or Revocation Order. The request must allege findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting the establishment's challenge. The Code Enforcement Board will hear the challenge at its next available regular meeting and shall conduct a de novo hearing in accordance with its regular rules of evidence and procedure.
